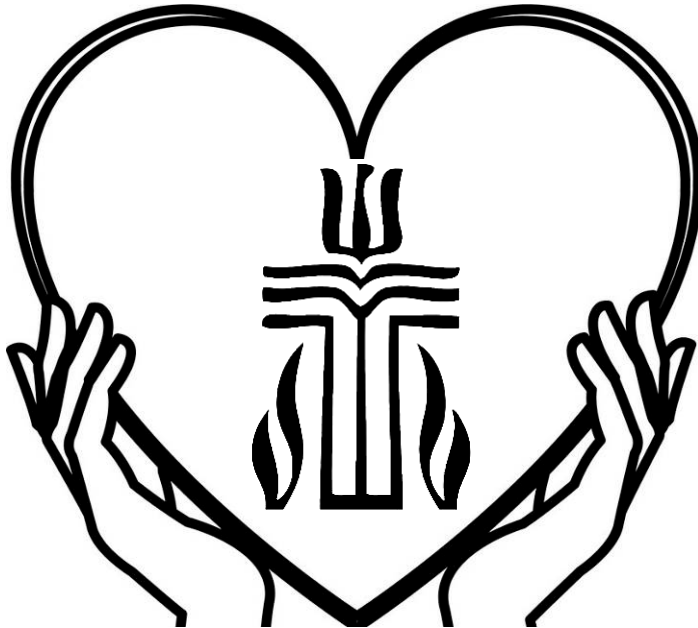

RECONCILING WITH GOD

CALL TO WORSHIP (Isaiah 52:7-8a)

Pastor: How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion ...

People: "Your God reigns!"

Pastor: Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices; together they shout for joy. Come, let us worship God.

***CALL TO CONFESSION (John 3:16, 17)**

Pastor: For God so loved the world that God gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

Pastor: Let us confess our need for God's saving love.

***PRAYER OF CONFESSION (Unison)**

We judge others all too freely. Our hasty words cause conflict and tension. We are disturbers of your peace. Forgive us for our mistaken priorities and narrowmindedness. Remind us through the Holy Spirit that you are the author of life and of our salvation and restore in us the sense of your ultimate claim upon our lives. We ask this in the name of Jesus our savior. Amen.
